Local security guide - Castle Hill NSW 2154 - Hills District, The Hills Shire

About Castle Hill

Castle Hill is about 30 km north-west of the Sydney CBD.

Castle Hill is the commercial heart of Sydney's Hills District, built around Castle Towers shopping centre and the Castle Hill Metro station, with leafy streets of family homes spreading out towards Cherrybrook and Kellyville. At the 2021 Census, 40,874 people lived in Castle Hill in about 13,224 occupied homes: 74% separate houses, 11% townhouses or semi-detached homes and 15% apartments, and 23% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Large family homes on generous blocks, townhouses and villas, and apartments near Castle Towers and the Metro station.

Castle Hill's older streets have brick family homes from the 1970s and 1980s on large, often sloping blocks with pools, back decks and side paths out of sight of the street. Townhouses, villas and apartment buildings have been added near Castle Towers and the Metro station. Many homes have double garages, but with several cars per household, one often stays in the driveway.

Common security concerns in Castle Hill

- Cars parked in driveways overnight
- Side paths and back yards out of sight on sloping blocks
- Shared entries in apartment buildings near the station

Local tip: Protect the second car in the driveway

About 63% of Castle Hill households had two or more cars at the 2021 Census, and cars parked in the driveway overnight are easy to reach. Use the garage for the car you can, keep keys and remotes inside away from the front door, and cover the driveway and side gates with sensor lighting and a camera that records clearly at night.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
