

Casula Security Report

Local security guide - Casula NSW 2170 - South-west Sydney, City of Liverpool

About Casula

Casula is about 32 km south-west of the Sydney CBD.

Casula sits on the western bank of the Georges River south of Liverpool, with Casula Mall, the Crossroads Homemaker Centre, the Casula Powerhouse Arts Centre and quiet residential streets close to the Hume Highway and the M5. BOCSAR recorded 857 criminal incidents in Casula in the year to June 2026 (not counting transport fines and breaches of bail or court orders), down from 902 the year before. Theft from shops (112) and fraud (96) were the largest groups, and there were 58 thefts from motor vehicles and 27 motor vehicle thefts.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Brick and brick-veneer family homes from the 1970s to the 1990s, duplexes and townhouses.

Casula is mostly a family suburb of single and double-storey brick homes built from the 1970s to the 1990s, many with a double garage, a front lawn and a back yard reached by a side gate, with newer duplexes and townhouses on subdivided blocks. The shopping centres near the Hume Highway draw traffic from across south-west Sydney, and homes near the river parklands back onto open space.

Common security concerns in Casula

- Mail theft and identity fraud
- Theft from cars and shops around the shopping centres
- Back yards that open onto parkland and reserves

Local tip: Lock the letterbox

Fraud was the second-largest offence group in Casula last year, and stolen mail is one of the ways identity fraud starts. A lockable letterbox, collecting mail every day, and a camera that covers the front of the house and the letterbox make it harder for someone to take bank cards or statements. Shred old documents instead of putting them in the recycling bin.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
