

Coorparoo Security Report

Local security guide - Coorparoo QLD 4151 - Inner south-east Brisbane, City of Brisbane

About Coorparoo

Coorparoo is about 5 km south-east of the Brisbane CBD.

Coorparoo is an inner south-east Brisbane suburb with Coorparoo Square, the Old Cleveland Road shops and restaurants, and a mix of character homes and apartments. At the 2021 Census, 18,132 people lived in Coorparoo in about 7,667 occupied homes: 41% separate houses, 9% townhouses or semi-detached homes and 50% apartments, and 45% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Timber Queenslanders and post-war homes, and apartment blocks near Old Cleveland Road.

Coorparoo's hills have timber Queenslanders and post-war homes, many raised with open under-house areas, louvres and verandahs, alongside walk-up apartment blocks and newer apartment buildings near Coorparoo Square. About 45% of homes were rented at the 2021 Census.

Common security concerns in Coorparoo

- Open car spaces and stairwells in walk-up blocks
- Under-house areas and louvres in Queenslanders
- Bikes and storage cages

Local tip: Walk-up blocks and Queenslanders

About half of Coorparoo's homes were apartments at the 2021 Census, many in older walk-up blocks with shared stairwells and open car spaces. Lock storage cages, bring bikes inside, and ask the body corporate about lighting and cameras in car parks. In Queenslanders, lock the under-house area and louvres.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
