Local security guide - Craigmore SA 5114 - Northern Adelaide, City of Playford

About Craigmore

Craigmore is about 28 km north of the Adelaide CBD.

Craigmore is a northern Adelaide suburb in the City of Playford, on the slopes east of Elizabeth, with streets of family homes and views across the plains. At the 2021 Census, 10,943 people lived in Craigmore in about 3,743 occupied homes: 99% separate houses, 0% townhouses or semi-detached homes and almost no apartments, and 20% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Brick family homes from the 1970s onwards, almost all separate houses.

Craigmore's streets climb the slopes east of Elizabeth, with brick family homes from the 1970s onwards on generous blocks, many with carports or single garages and back yards reached by a side path. About 99% of homes were separate houses at the 2021 Census.

Common security concerns in Craigmore

- Side paths to the back yard
- Carports and driveways
- Homes empty during the day

Local tip: Fencing, lighting and a camera

Almost every Craigmore home is a separate house, about 52% being paid off with a mortgage at the 2021 Census. Good fencing with a lockable side gate, sensor lighting at the front and side, and a camera covering the driveway and street are practical first steps.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
