Local security guide - Crestmead QLD 4132 - Western Logan, City of Logan

About Crestmead

Crestmead is about 27 km south of the Brisbane CBD.

Crestmead is a residential suburb in the west of the City of Logan, next to Browns Plains and Marsden, with a large industrial estate and mostly family homes built from the 1980s onwards. The Queensland Police Service recorded 4,744 offences against the person and property in the Crestmead police division in 2025-26, up from 4,360 the year before. Assault (844), property damage (640) and theft from vehicles (596) were among the largest groups, and there were 394 unlawful entries into homes.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Low-set brick homes from the 1980s and 1990s, newer estate homes, duplexes and townhouses.

Crestmead's residential streets are made up mostly of low-set brick homes built from the 1980s onwards, with newer estates, duplexes and townhouses added as Logan has grown. Most homes have a double garage and a fenced back yard, and many households have more than one car parked in the driveway. The industrial estate brings trucks and trade traffic through the area during the week.

Common security concerns in Crestmead

- Warehouses and yards in the industrial estate after hours
- Break-ins to homes and theft from cars in driveways
- Property damage to homes, cars and fences

Local tip: Industrial units: alarms, gates and patrol response

The Crestmead industrial estate has many warehouses, workshops and yards that sit empty overnight and on weekends, and more than a third of unlawful entries in the division last year were into non-residential buildings. Businesses there get the most from a monitored alarm with patrol response, cameras covering gates, roller doors and the yard, perimeter lighting, and a routine that makes sure gates are locked and alarms set at close.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
