Local security guide - Fairfield NSW 2165 - South-west Sydney, City of Fairfield

About Fairfield

Fairfield is about 27 km west of the Sydney CBD.

Fairfield is the administrative centre of the City of Fairfield, with Neeta City and Fairfield Forum, the Ware Street shops and a busy railway station, and one of Sydney's most culturally diverse communities. BOCSAR recorded 1,356 criminal incidents in Fairfield in the year to June 2026 (not counting transport fines and breaches of bail or court orders), up from 1,294 the year before. Non-domestic assault (157), intimidation, stalking and harassment (147) and malicious damage (122) were the largest groups.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Walk-up units and apartments near the station, post-war brick and fibro houses, and duplexes and villas.

Fairfield's town centre is ringed by walk-up units and newer apartment blocks, and the surrounding streets have post-war brick and fibro houses, many replaced by duplexes and villas. Its shopping streets are lined with small, family-run businesses, and the centre stays busy into the evening. Homes are close together, so cameras should be angled to cover your own property without looking into neighbours' yards.

Common security concerns in Fairfield

- Assaults and damage in public places around the town centre at night
- Shopfronts and small businesses closing up after dark
- Homes close together, where cameras need careful placement

Local tip: Light the way in after dark

Much of Fairfield's recorded crime happens in public places around the town centre and station, especially at night. For businesses, good lighting, cameras that cover the shopfront and the street, and staff who close up in pairs make a real difference. At home, a sensor light and a camera on the path from the street to your front door help if you come home after dark.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
