Local security guide - Hallett Cove SA 5158 - Southern Adelaide, City of Marion

About Hallett Cove

Hallett Cove is about 20 km south of the Adelaide CBD.

Hallett Cove is a coastal suburb in the City of Marion in Adelaide's south, known for Hallett Cove Conservation Park and its clifftop boardwalk, with a shopping centre, station and hillside family homes. At the 2021 Census, 12,512 people lived in Hallett Cove in about 4,709 occupied homes: 95% separate houses, 5% townhouses or semi-detached homes and almost no apartments, and 14% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Brick family homes on hillside blocks from the 1970s onwards, almost all separate houses.

Hallett Cove's streets climb the hills above the coast, with brick family homes from the 1970s onwards, many split-level with sea views, decks and garages below street level. About 95% of homes were separate houses at the 2021 Census. Coastal wind and salt air wear out outdoor equipment.

Common security concerns in Hallett Cove

- Homes empty while owners travel
- Salt air wearing outdoor equipment
- Split-level homes with hidden entries

Local tip: Travelling and coastal weather

About 39% of Hallett Cove homes were owned outright at the 2021 Census, and the median age was 43. If you travel, put lights on timers, have mail collected and use an alarm or cameras that alert your phone. Coastal homes should use outdoor cameras and lights rated for salt air.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
