

Kallangur Security Report

Local security guide - Kallangur QLD 4503 - Moreton Bay, northern greater Brisbane

About Kallangur

Kallangur is about 25 km north of the Brisbane CBD.

Kallangur is a Moreton Bay suburb on the Redcliffe Peninsula rail line, with a station, local shopping centres and a mix of older homes and townhouses between Petrie and North Lakes. At the 2021 Census, 21,761 people lived in Kallangur in about 8,101 occupied homes: 74% separate houses, 22% townhouses or semi-detached homes and almost no apartments, and 43% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Low-set brick homes from the 1970s and 1980s, townhouses and units, and newer homes.

Kallangur has low-set brick homes from the 1970s and 1980s on quarter-acre blocks, many with carports, alongside townhouse complexes and newer homes. About 43% of homes were rented at the 2021 Census. Its station and the main roads through the suburb bring traffic from across the region.

Common security concerns in Kallangur

- Townhouse complexes with shared entries
- Carports rather than garages
- Rented homes

Local tip: Townhouse complexes

About 22% of Kallangur homes were townhouses or semi-detached at the 2021 Census. In a townhouse complex, check that the entry gate and visitor parking are well lit, ask the body corporate about cameras on shared areas, and fit a deadlock and security screen to your own front and back doors.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
