Local security guide - Lindisfarne TAS 7015 - Greater Hobart, Clarence City Council

About Lindisfarne

Lindisfarne is about 6 km north-east of the Hobart CBD.

Lindisfarne is an eastern shore suburb in the City of Clarence on Lindisfarne Bay, with a village shopping strip and family homes on the hills facing the Tasman Bridge and Hobart. At the 2021 Census, 6,639 people lived in Lindisfarne in about 2,612 occupied homes: 88% separate houses, 9% townhouses or semi-detached homes and 2% apartments, and 22% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Brick and weatherboard family homes from the post-war decades onwards, mostly separate houses.

Lindisfarne's streets have brick and weatherboard family homes from the post-war decades onwards on hillside blocks, many with water views and garages below the house. About 88% of homes were separate houses at the 2021 Census.

Common security concerns in Lindisfarne

- Original locks in older homes
- Unsolicited callers at the door
- Garages below the house

Local tip: Updating an established home

Lindisfarne's median age was 46 at the 2021 Census, and many homes have been owned for decades. Updating old locks, adding keyed window locks and a video doorbell, and considering a monitored alarm are simple steps. Be wary of anyone at the door offering unsolicited repairs.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
