Local security guide - Liverpool NSW 2170 - South-west Sydney, City of Liverpool

About Liverpool

Liverpool is about 31 km south-west of the Sydney CBD.

Liverpool is the main centre of south-west Sydney, on the Georges River, with Westfield Liverpool, Liverpool Hospital, the Macquarie Street mall and the courts and offices around the station. BOCSAR recorded 14,574 criminal incidents in Liverpool in the year to June 2026, but 8,205 of them were transport regulatory offences and another 1,504 were offences against justice procedures such as breach of bail. Leaving those out, the count was 4,865, up from 4,545 the year before, with theft from shops (378) and malicious damage (345) among the largest groups.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Apartment blocks around the town centre, post-war brick and fibro cottages, villas and townhouses.

The streets around Liverpool's town centre have filled with apartment blocks since the 2000s, while further from the centre the suburb still has post-war brick and fibro cottages on quarter-acre-style blocks, many now subdivided for villas and townhouses. Houses often have a side gate, a carport and a back door that cannot be seen from the street. Shops, medical suites and offices around the hospital and Macquarie Street need alarms and cameras that work after hours.

Common security concerns in Liverpool

- Back sliding doors and side gates on older cottages
- Theft and damage around the Macquarie Street mall and the station
- Medical suites and offices near the hospital left empty overnight

Local tip: Upgrade the back sliding door

Many older Liverpool cottages have an aluminium sliding door at the back that can be lifted out of its track. Fit anti-lift blocks and a keyed lock to the slider, or add a security screen door, and put a sensor light over the back yard. BOCSAR recorded 110 break-ins to homes in Liverpool last year.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
