

Narangba Security Report

Local security guide - Narangba QLD 4504 - Moreton Bay, northern greater Brisbane

About Narangba

Narangba is about 35 km north of the Brisbane CBD.

Narangba is a family suburb in the Moreton Bay region with a station on the Caboolture line, local shopping centres, an industrial estate and acreage blocks on its western side. At the 2021 Census, 20,910 people lived in Narangba in about 6,454 occupied homes: 96% separate houses, 4% townhouses or semi-detached homes and almost no apartments, and 24% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Low-set brick family homes, newer estates, and acreage and rural-residential blocks.

Narangba's streets have low-set brick family homes with double garages, while acreage blocks to the west have sheds, horse paddocks and long driveways out of sight of the road. About 96% of homes were separate houses at the 2021 Census. The industrial estate needs yard security and after-hours alarms.

Common security concerns in Narangba

- Sheds, trailers and boats on acreage
- Several cars per household
- Industrial yards after hours

Local tip: Cars, sheds and trailers on bigger blocks

About 75% of Narangba households had two or more cars at the 2021 Census, and acreage blocks add sheds, trailers and boats. Lock sheds and trailers, record serial numbers, keep keys inside, and fit a driveway alert or solar camera that notifies your phone.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
