Local security guide - Parafield Gardens SA 5107 - Northern Adelaide, City of Salisbury

About Parafield Gardens

Parafield Gardens is about 17 km north of the Adelaide CBD.

Parafield Gardens is a northern Adelaide suburb in the City of Salisbury, next to Parafield Airport, with local shopping centres and streets of family homes built mostly from the 1970s onwards. At the 2021 Census, 18,467 people lived in Parafield Gardens in about 6,141 occupied homes: 89% separate houses, 8% townhouses or semi-detached homes and 2% apartments, and 28% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Brick family homes from the 1970s onwards and newer estates, mostly separate houses.

Parafield Gardens has brick family homes from the 1970s onwards on generous blocks, many with carports or single garages, and newer estates with double garages. About 89% of homes were separate houses at the 2021 Census.

Common security concerns in Parafield Gardens

- Cars in driveways and carports
- Garages left open
- Side paths to the back yard

Local tip: Keys, cars and the garage

About 61% of Parafield Gardens households had two or more cars at the 2021 Census. Keep keys and fobs inside and away from the front door, lock every car, and cover the driveway with a camera and sensor light. Close the garage door every time.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
