Local security guide - Paralowie SA 5108 - Northern Adelaide, City of Salisbury

About Paralowie

Paralowie is about 20 km north of the Adelaide CBD.

Paralowie is a northern Adelaide suburb in the City of Salisbury, west of Salisbury's town centre, with local shopping, schools and estates built mostly from the 1980s onwards. At the 2021 Census, 17,504 people lived in Paralowie in about 5,895 occupied homes: 94% separate houses, 5% townhouses or semi-detached homes and almost no apartments, and 24% of homes were rented.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Brick family homes from the 1980s onwards, almost all separate houses.

Paralowie is made up mostly of single-storey brick homes built from the 1980s onwards, with carports or garages and fenced back yards, and reserves and walking trails through the suburb. About 94% of homes were separate houses at the 2021 Census.

Common security concerns in Paralowie

- Homes empty during the working day
- Side gates and back yards
- Carports and driveways

Local tip: While everyone is at work

About half of Paralowie's homes were being paid off with a mortgage at the 2021 Census, many empty during the working day. A monitored alarm or one that alerts your phone, a video doorbell and keyed window locks all help. Lock the side gate and keep the garage door closed.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
