

# Parramatta Security Report

Local security guide - Parramatta NSW 2150 - Western Sydney, City of Parramatta

## About Parramatta

Parramatta is about 24 km west of the Sydney CBD.

Parramatta is Sydney's second CBD, home to Parramatta Square, Westfield Parramatta, the Church Street dining strip and large state government offices, with thousands of apartments around the river and the station. BOCSAR recorded 6,504 criminal incidents in Parramatta in the year to June 2026 (not counting transport fines and breaches of bail or court orders), up from 6,041 the year before and second only to the Sydney CBD. Theft from shops (1,013) and receiving or handling stolen goods (462) were among the largest groups.

## Housing and local context

**Housing stock: High-rise apartments, walk-up units from the 1960s to 1980s, older freestanding houses, offices and shops.**

Parramatta has changed quickly: apartment towers now line the river and the streets around the station and Parramatta Square, while older walk-up blocks of units and freestanding houses remain on the side streets further out. Strata buildings share car parks, bike rooms and parcel areas, so most camera and access upgrades go through the owners corporation. Offices, shops and restaurants in the CBD and along Church Street need after-hours alarms and cameras that cover rear lanes and loading areas.

## Common security concerns in Parramatta

- Theft from cars and storage cages in shared apartment car parks
- Theft from shops around Westfield Parramatta and Church Street
- Offices and restaurants with rear lanes and loading areas that are quiet after hours

## Local tip: Treat the shared car park like a public street

Basement car parks under Parramatta's apartment blocks are shared by hundreds of residents, visitors and delivery drivers, and BOCSAR recorded 180 thefts from motor vehicles in the suburb last year. Treat your space like a public street: leave nothing on show, lock storage cages, and ask your strata committee for cameras on the car park entry, exit and lift lobby.

**Before you hire: checklist**

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register ([abr.business.gov.au](http://abr.business.gov.au)).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
