Local security guide - Redcliffe QLD 4020 - Redcliffe Peninsula, Moreton Bay

About Redcliffe

Redcliffe is about 28 km north-east of the Brisbane CBD.

Redcliffe sits on the Redcliffe Peninsula in the Moreton Bay region, with a seaside esplanade, Redcliffe Jetty, Suttons Beach and a shopping and dining strip along Redcliffe Parade, connected to Brisbane's northern suburbs by the Houghton Highway bridge. The Queensland Police Service recorded 4,743 offences against the person and property in the Redcliffe police division in 2025-26, up from 4,341 the year before. Shop stealing (929) was the largest group, followed by other stealing (751), assault (608) and property damage (601).

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Old beach houses and Queenslanders, 1960s and 1970s brick homes, units and apartment towers along the waterfront.

Redcliffe grew as a seaside holiday town, and its streets still mix old beach houses and timber Queenslanders with brick homes from the 1960s and 1970s and blocks of units and apartment towers along the waterfront. Redcliffe Parade and the jetty draw visitors year-round, especially on weekends and for markets and events. Older homes often have louvre windows and open undercroft areas, while units share car parks and entries.

Common security concerns in Redcliffe

- Shop theft around Redcliffe Parade and the shopping centres
- Units and holiday homes left empty for periods
- Older homes with louvre windows and open undercroft areas

Local tip: Don't let an empty unit look empty

Some Redcliffe units and apartments along the waterfront are holiday homes or sit empty for part of the year, and older blocks often have open car spaces and ground-floor storage. Timer lights, a camera you can check from your phone, deadlocks on the entry and balcony doors, and a neighbour who clears the mail keep an empty unit from looking empty.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
