

Upper Mount Gravatt Security Report

Local security guide - Upper Mount Gravatt QLD 4122 - South-east Brisbane, City of Brisbane

About Upper Mount Gravatt

Upper Mount Gravatt is about 11 km south-east of the Brisbane CBD.

Upper Mount Gravatt, south-east of the CBD, is home to Westfield Mt Gravatt, one of Brisbane's largest shopping centres, along with the Garden City busway station and quiet residential streets. The Queensland Police Service recorded 6,427 offences against the person and property in the Upper Mount Gravatt police division in 2025-26, almost the same as the 6,397 the year before. Shop stealing (1,635) was the largest group, reflecting the shopping centre, and there were 490 unlawful entries into homes, the most of any police division in greater Brisbane.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Post-war timber and brick houses, low-set 1960s and 1970s homes, and units and townhouses near the shopping centre.

Upper Mount Gravatt's residential streets have post-war timber and brick homes, many low-set houses from the 1960s and 1970s, and newer units and townhouses near the shopping centre and busway. People and traffic move through the area all day because of the centre, while the streets behind it stay quiet. On sloping blocks, back doors and windows are often hidden from the street.

Common security concerns in Upper Mount Gravatt

- Break-ins through back doors and windows hidden from the street
- Shop theft around Westfield Mt Gravatt
- Theft from cars at the shopping centre and busway

Local tip: Lock the doors and windows you can't see from the street

The Upper Mount Gravatt division recorded 490 unlawful entries into homes last year. A back or side door or window that can't be seen from the street gives someone time to work unseen. Keyed locks on windows, a security screen on the back door, a sensor light on the side path and an alarm you set every time you go out, and at night, make a house a much harder target.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
