

Wynnum Security Report

Local security guide - Wynnum QLD 4178 - Bayside Brisbane

About Wynnum

Wynnum is about 15 km east of the Brisbane CBD on Moreton Bay.

Wynnum is a bayside suburb with a mix of older Queenslanders, renovated cottages, and newer townhouse developments. The esplanade and foreshore draw visitors through the day and evening, and many homes are elevated Queenslanders with storage or parking underneath, which adds ground-level access points to think about.

Housing and local context

Housing stock: Queenslanders, renovated cottages, townhouses, some new builds.

Wynnum's older streets are full of Queenslanders and post-war timber workers' cottages set up on stumps, with open or partly enclosed under-house areas at ground level. Newer townhouses cluster closer to Wynnum Central station and the shopping strip. Timber homes on stumps have plenty of mounting points under the eaves, but the open under-house areas and side yards where boats and trailers are parked are often the least visible parts of the property.

Common security concerns in Wynnum

- Theft of outboard motors, fishing gear, bikes and tools from under-house areas and side yards
- Boats, trailers and vehicles parked in driveways or on the street overnight
- Salt-laden air from the bay corroding cheap camera housings, brackets and connectors within a few years

Local tip: Lock up the under-house level of raised Queenslanders

Elevated Queenslanders in Wynnum often have underneath areas used for storage or parking that are open at ground level. If your home is raised, consider enclosing or locking the underneath level with a gate or roller door, and make sure any cameras and lighting cover it, since it can be reached without being seen from the street.

Before you hire: checklist

- Look up the licence number on the relevant state regulator register and confirm it is current.
- Check the ABN on the Australian Business Register (abr.business.gov.au).
- Hardwired 240V work needs a licensed electrician; in-wall data cabling needs an ACMA-registered cabler.
- For guards and patrols, confirm both the firm licence and each attending officer's licence.
- Get at least three written quotes listing camera models, recorder storage and warranty.
- Aim cameras at your own property and consider disabling audio on cameras facing shared areas.
